SEAS has become a hub for adaptive sailing for children and adults with cognitive and/or physical disabilities. In fact, the Para World Sailing Championships were held in Sheboygan in September of 2018

Things to know:

Closed toe shoes are required (no sandals or flip-flops, running shoes work great) – Bring layers of clothing as it can get colder out on the water. Bring a waterproof/water resistant jacket as you may get splashed with water. SEAS will provide life jackets
